## Checking on the status of your Student Intent Form

After submitting your Student Intent to Graduate Form, your advisor or department chair will review your academic advisement report in iRattler to determine if you are ready to apply for graduation.

Once your department determines if you are ready to apply, you will receive a service indicator called ETA (Eligible to Apply)

After receiving the ETA on your account, you will need to login to you iRattler account and apply for graduation.
